CHARACTERISTICS OF THE COASTAL PLAIN ECOREGION

- •This ecoregion encompasses more land than any other ecoregion in the state.
- •It is characterized by mostly sandy loamy soils.
- •It is relatively flat with subtle changes in elevation making a difference between upland and lowland areas.
- •The driest months tend to be April and October.
- Plant communities are defined primarily by soil moisture and fire frequency.

WHAT ARE NATIVE PLANTS?

- Native plants are species that grow naturally in this region and are adapted to local physical and biological conditions, and to frequent fires. They have co-evolved over time with other organisms of the region.
- Cultivars of native plants have been selectively bred. Because they have diminished genetic diversity, they are more susceptible to disease and less capable of supporting wildlife.

WHAT ARE INVASIVE PLANTS?

- •Invasive plants are not native to a given ecosystem and are likely to cause environmental harm.
- •They tend to out-compete native species because they have no natural predators, diseases, or competitors.
- •They have much less value to native pollinators, birds, and other wildlife than native plants.

BENEFITS OF NATIVE PLANTS

- Native plants promote biodiversity and foster appreciation for our natural communities.
- •They provide habitat for all types of wildlife, satisfying their needs for food, shelter, health, and reproduction.
- After establishment, they require less landscape and garden maintenance.

USING NATIVE PLANTS

- Coastal Plain planting zones are 7-9, with suggested planting between October and February.
- •Visit natural areas near where you live and observe which plants are growing together. Create similar plant communities in your garden.
- Match plants with the right soil, moisture, and light conditions.
- Plant only nursery-propagated plant material.
- Provide initial care the first year, as for any newly planted landscape plants.

PROTECTING NATIVE PLANT COMMUNITIES

- Learn about and protect native plants and their natural communities.
- **Do not** remove plants from the wild unless participating in a legitimate and authorized "plant rescue" program.
- •Remove invasive plants where possible as soon as possible.
- Do not plant invasive species, no matter how pretty they are.
