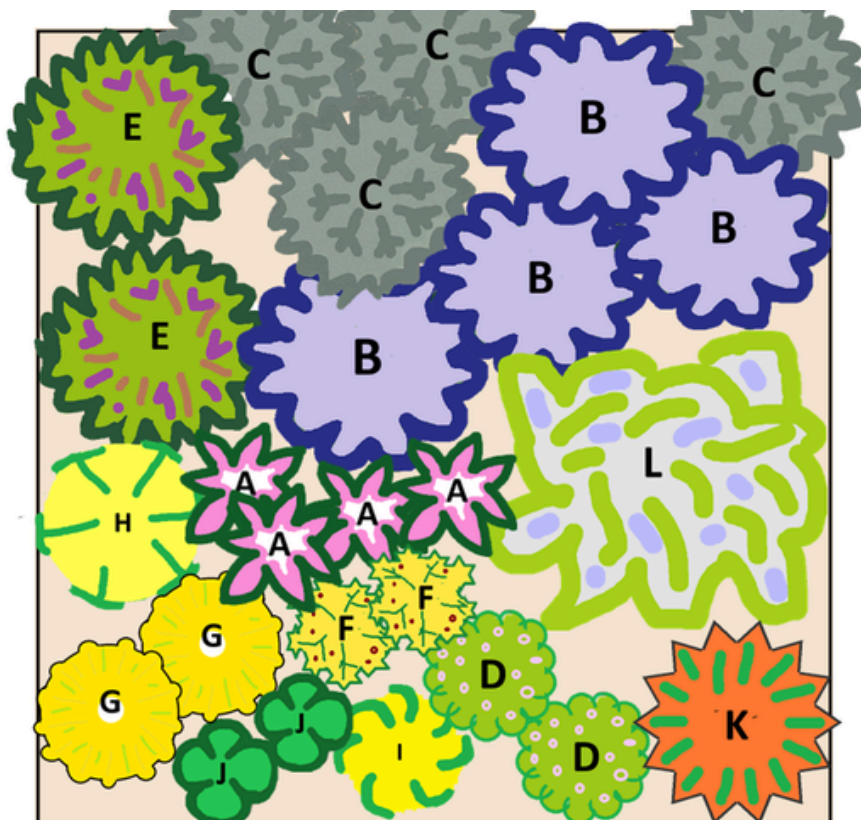

PLANTING TIPS

- The suggested planting encourages dense planting and the design fills a 7' x 7' area or almost 50 sq ft.
- Select a location that receives at least 6 hours of full sun a day.
- Plant directly in the ground, not in a container or raised bed.
- Define the edge around the garden or add other cues to care.
- Remove any turf grass or other vegetation from the planting area.
- If planting into compacted clay soil, amend with compost or soil conditioner.
- The planting hole should be 2-3 times wider than the root ball but only deep enough to cover the roots.
- Water the new installation for the first 2 weeks. Additional watering may be needed if there is no rain for 2 weeks.

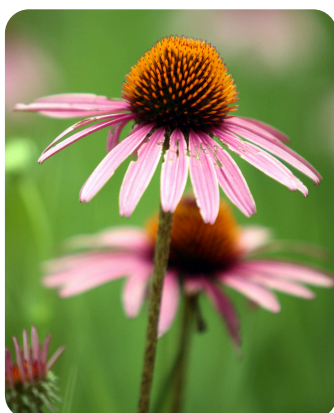

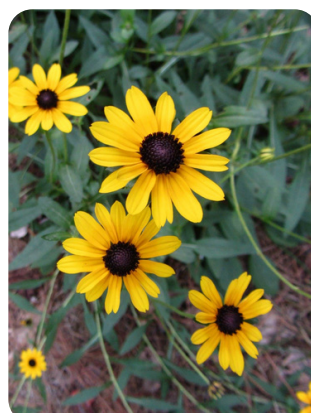
